

AMPHITHEATER COMMITTEE MEETING
MONDAY, MAY 9, 2011
6:00 P.M.

The Amphitheater Food committee met on the above date and time at the Edward Jones Conference Room, 1905 N. Main Street, Rushville. Cindy Humphrey and Carla Sharpe were on hand to discuss Community Day on May 21st.

Sharpe reported:

- due to no hogs being donated this year we have decided to serve hamburgers and hotdogs.

We will be purchasing from Save-A-Lot 75 pounds of hamburger @ \$2.28 a pound, or whatever the price is on the 21st, if lower. This will serve 300 people. These hamburgers will come in quarter pound patties for a total of \$171.00.

- Dennis and Pavey's have donated 2 cases of hotdogs. There is 24 packages per case, 48 packs at \$1.99 a pack, 10 dogs per pack for a total of 480 hotdogs.

They also donated 300 hotdog buns at \$1.39 a pack and 400 hamburger buns at \$1.39 a pack.

We will be 180 hot dog buns short. After making a phone call, Pavey's will donate another 180 hotdog buns to go with the hotdogs.

- J & D. Meats is donating 4 pans of slaw which feeds 75 people per pan. And 5 pans of baked beans which feeds 50 people per pan. Sharpe has asked that the beans already be cooked and hot at pickup.

Sharpe will pick up beans and slaw around 10:00 am on May 21st.

If you have a roaster oven and crock pots please bring to Community Day to put food in.

- Turn ice machine on at beginning of week to make sure it works.

Humphrey reported:

- Pizza King is donating chips but we may need to buy a couple more bags as we ran out last year.
- We have plenty of forks, spoons, cups and napkins from last year.
- Will put the slaw on ice.
- Will need to pick up paper towels, at least 320 plates, ketchup, mustard, relish, pickles and mayo.
- Will continue to try to get items donated but just in case we will need to purchase the above.
- Pavey and Rathz will check on the gas for the grill.
- Will serve water, lemonade and tea, all of which will have to be purchased if not donated.
- Peggy Stout is in charge of games.
- Humphrey and Sharpe are in charge of food.
- Asbury is in charge of bake sale and cake walk. She will ask A. Grocox to help her.
- C. Grocox is in charge of music.
- Strobl will be in charge of drinks.
- Strobl and Gardner will be in charge of the condiments table.

- Humphrey will serve the chips and slaw.
- Sharpe will serve the beans. Sharpe and Reide will serve the hamburgers and hotdogs.
- Miller will work the bun table and stock the plate's napkins and forks.
- Macy, C. Stout, Richardson and J. Rathz will man the grill.
- K. Rathz and Fussner will run the silent auction.
- We will set up tent, tables and chairs Friday night.
- Tables will need to be cleaned.


It was reported that:

- We will put the big tent up before the first concert.
- The trailer is ours. Ready for us to pick up. This will be part cash and part in kind sponsorship from Campbell Brothers Auto.
- The flyers are printed. K. Rathz will get them to the group.
- Everyone is to bring four baked items to Community Day. Two for the bake sale and two for the cake walk.
- We will set up tent, table, chairs and extension cords Friday night at 6:30 p.m.
- Rathz reported everyone interested in giving blood at the blood mobile needs to go on line and register a time slot. You may also let Kim know and she will register for you.
- Continue to bring in auction items. Items posted on website and Facebook.
- The Police Department will have a Police car there for kids to see and an officer to speak to the kids.
- The Fire Department will also have a Fire truck there for kids to see and firemen to speak to the kids.
- Dennis Craven will be there to sell Amphitheater T-Shirts.
- Rathz would like to have the curtains behind auction area closed so people can't walk in from behind. Everyone will help with curtains as C. Stout is still recovering from shoulder surgery.

- Asbury handed out Treasurer's report. Current balance in checkbook is \$2,948.69 after an \$88.00 check had been written to K. Rathz for postage to mail Community Day donation letters out.
- Sharpe handed out the list of Sponsors to the group. To date we have raised \$51,088.33 total. \$34,038.33 of that is cash sponsorship. \$17,050.00 of that is in kind sponsorship. Total concert series will cost \$29,353.75 minus the \$34,038.33 in cash; we will be over \$4,684.58 to cover other or unexpected expenses that may come up.
