

**MEETING OF THE CITY OF RUSHVILLE, INDIANA  
BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY  
DECEMBER 3, 2013  
5:30 P.M.**

**CALL TO ORDER:** The City of Rushville Board of Public Works and Safety met on the above date and time at 270 West 15<sup>th</sup> Street, Rushville, Indiana. Mayor Pavey called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

**ROLL CALL:** Gary Cameron, Darrin McGowan, and Ron Jarman answered roll call. Member, Angie Barton was not present. Also present were City Attorney, Julie Newhouse, and Frank Denzler, *Rushville Republican*.

**MINUTES:** Minutes of the November 19, 2013 meeting were presented for approval. Jarman made a motion to approve the minutes as presented. McGowan seconded the motion. Motion carried.

**MAYOR'S REPORT:** None.

**CLERK-TREASURER'S REPORT:** None.

**DEPARTMENT HEAD REPORTS:**

**Police** – Chief Tucker said they are taking applications until the end of the week.

**Fire** – Chief Jenkins said he received a \$1,000 grant from Wal-Mart. The money will be used for smoke detectors & batteries.

Jenkins said he met with John Livingston, from Varmit Guard. He is checking out the bird problem and will report back.

**Street** – Commissioner Miller said he will be attending a conference in Louisville on levees.

**Park** – Park Director Mathews said he applied for a grant with the Rush County Community Foundation and received \$4,450.00 to complete the heating and air conditioning at Laughlin Shelter. He said this will be a year round shelter.

**CITIZEN CONCERNS/COMMENTS:** None.

**UNFINISHED BUSINESS:**

1. **Ambulance** – Jenkins said he is still waiting on the second ambulance. The door has been installed and they are working on completing the interior portion.
2. **Craven Property – Advertising** – The advertisement has been sent to the newspaper.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

1. **424 West 1<sup>st</sup> Street – Sale of Property** – Newhouse said she has requested appraisals. She received a phone call from Susan Tebbe stating that the neighbors were interested in purchasing the property.
2. **Letter of Support-Cherry Street “Rushville Industrial Corridor”**- Prior to Dec 13 we will submit a packet for Phase 1 for the Rushville industrial corridor project. The project consists of the entry south of the new industrial park and just east of PKG. This will make a smoother flow of traffic. Phase 2 will be a north south connector between Harcourt Way and 200 North. The project was broken into 2 phases upon the recommendation by INDOT.
3. **Commercial Property Appraisals** - Jarman made a motion to get appraisals on 2 pieces of commercial property that we have an interest in. McGowan seconded the motion. Motion carried.

**ADJOURN:** There was no further business to come before the Board; Cameron made a motion to adjourn. McGowan seconded the motion. The meeting adjourned at 5:40 p.m.
