

MEETING OF THE RUSHVILLE, INDIANA BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY

AUGUST 6, 2013

5:30 P.M.

CALL TO ORDER: The City of Rushville Board of Public Works and Safety met on the above date and time at 270 West 15th Street, Rushville, Indiana. Mayor Pavey called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

ROLL CALL: Gary Cameron, Darrin McGowan, Angie Barton, and Ron Jarman answered roll call. Also present was City Attorney, Julie Newhouse.

MINUTES: Minutes of the July 16, 2013 meeting were presented for approval. Barton made a motion to approve the minutes as presented. Cameron seconded the motion. Motion carried.

DEPARTMENT HEAD REPORTS:

Police – Chief Tucker said he has received the paper work back from Public Safety Medical on the 2 gentlemen that we have offered conditional employment to. The paperwork has been forwarded to the proper authorities and it is expected to be approximately another 30 days before they will be able to start their employment with the City. They are currently volunteering their time to go through the mandatory pre-basic training. They have also indicated that they would continue to come down to continue to train.

Chief Tucker said the Police Department is starting a new program “Coffee with a Cop”. Officers will meet for coffee and conversation with the public. The program will begin August 21st at the Park Restaurant from 7:00 a.m. – 10:00 a.m. Tucker said he hopes this will help the public to get to know the officers and feel comfortable talking to them. He said they are hoping to do this once a month.

Street – Street Commissioner said the sidewalk program will end this Friday.
