

The Rushville City Utilities would like to inform their customers that starting Monday July 30th we will be starting a valve replacement program, this will involve replacing 19 broken valves throughout the city water system. The valve replacement will involve replacing valves in sections of 2 to 3 valves per week until all 19 valves are replaced. During this time the customers in those sections where the valves are being replaced will be required to be on a boil water advisory which is mandatory when the water pressure drops below 20 psi, those customers will be notified in advance when it becomes necessary. Unfortunately, customers throughout the city may experience rusty water due to the shutting of valves during the valve replacement program. We understand that this might be an inconvenience to some but once the broken valves are replaced it will allow for better flushing of the water system therefore eliminating some of the rusty water issues of the past. Below is a tentative schedule of the valve replacement program depending on weather conditions and other issues that might arise.

1. July 30th = 215 East 5th
2. Aug 6th = 616 East 8th and 8th Maple
3. Aug 13th = Perkins and Hospital Drive and 13th and Willow
4. Aug 21st = 10th Benjamin and 518 East 10th
5. Aug 27th = 9th Morgan – 8th Harrison and 10th Jackson
6. Sept 3rd = 12th George.
7. Sept 10th = 11th Perkins – 12th Perkins and 9th Perkins
8. Sept 17th = 3rd Morgan – 3rd Sexton and Water Morgan
