MINUTES FOR THE MEETING OF THE RUSHVILLE ADVISORY PLAN COMMISSION

January 20, 2021
6:00P.M.

Call to Order: The Rushville Advisory Plan Commission met on the above date and time in Council Chambers. President Shawn Adkins called the meeting to order at 6:24pm.

ROLL CALL: Shawn Adkins, Brad Berkemeier, Doug Corn, Jeff Houser, Kim Mahan, Joe Rathz and Ross Winters.

Deputy Director Carmen Clark was also in attendance.

2021 Election of Officers: Mr. Corn made a motion to retain President Shawn Adkins for 2021. Mr. Rathz seconded the motion. There were no other nominations for president. All members voted aye for President Adkins to remain for 2021. Motion carried.

Mr. Houser made a motion for Mr. Rathz to be the Vice President. Mr. Corn seconded the motion. There were no other nominations. All in favor. Motion carried.

Minutes: Mr. Houser made a motion to approve the December 16th minutes as presented. Mr. Berkemeier seconded the motion. All in favor. Motion carried.

Old Business: There was no old business.

New Business:

Resolution 2021-01: amendment to Article X, Signs, Section H, to insert a new item #4 and renumber the remainder of the section. Ms. Clark stated the amendment is to put specifications and limitations on park signage. The public parks are located in R-1, Single-Family Residential Zoning District. Limiting the size of public park signage near residential neighborhoods is needed.

Public Hearing: No one spoke at this time. President Adkins closed the public hearing.

Mr. Rathz said he disagreed with the amendment and felt it wasn't needed. There is an exemption for public signage. Ms. Mahan stated she would hate to live across the street from a park and see a 10 foot tall sign.

Mr. Corn made a motion for a favorable recommendation for Resolution 2021-01. Mr. Winters seconded the motion. All in favor except Mr. Rathz voted nay. Motion carried.

Resolution 2021-02: update Thoroughfare Functional Classification Map. Ms. Clark explained the Thoroughfare Map needs approved to be added to the updated 2021 City of Rushville Comprehensive Plan. There will be a special meeting on January 27th to review and make a recommendation for the Comprehensive Plan.

Public Hearing: No one spoke. President Adkins closed the public hearing.

Mr. Rathz felt the "possible" future road projects were very vague. Mr. Rathz feels there should be a functional classification map and a map for future road projects. Mr. Rathz thought this should be tabled and discussed at the special meeting when more information is available.

Mr. Rathz made a motion to table Resolution 2021-02 until the special meeting on January 27th at 6pm. Mr. Corn seconded the motion. All in favor. Motion carried.


Reports:
