Under Customer Concerns, there was a request for a leak adjustment from Deby Priddy for her building at 116 W 2<sup>nd</sup> Street in the amount of \$1,019.82. The Board decided that if Ms. Priddy had a plumber come in and make repairs, an adjustment for the repair costs would be credited to the account. Ms. Priddy will be notified of the Board's decision and allow her to make the decision whether to hire a plumber or pay the current bill.

Under Unfinished Business, Greg presented two quotes for the sewer work to be done at 11<sup>th</sup> and Spencer Streets. The first quote was from EnviroGSolutions in the amount of \$31,250.00. The second quote was from L & S Sanitation Service in the amount of \$8,900.00. After a discussion on the matter, the Board members agreed to give the work to L & S Sanitation Service provided they are bonded. Gary Cameron motioned to approve. Phil King seconded the motion. The motion carried.

It was Phil King month to check claims. Phil motioned to approve the claims. Maria seconded the motion. The motion carried.
