Minutes of the Utility Board Meeting, August 8, 2023 The Board of Works met at the City Center Council Chambers

Mayor Pavey called the meeting to order.

Gary Cameron motioned to approve the July 11, 2023 board minutes. Brad Berkemeier seconded the motion. The motion carried.

During the Utility Superintendent's report, Greg told everyone that there were no violations at the Wastewater plant in July. There was one violation at the Water plant due to a water sample being positive for coliform, but no e-coli was present and there was no need for a Boil Water Advisory. Greg informed everyone that the Diamond Pet Foods project is 50% complete. The new water tower has been installed and the foundation for the new booster station has been poured. The unaccounted loss of water was at 16% in July.

Gina told everyone that the unaccounted loss may be due to volunteer fire departments filling their tanks without turning in their water usage to fill pools. Gina said that she has not had any department turn in their usage this year to be invoiced. A letter will need to be sent out to all the volunteer departments next spring to remind them that they need to be invoiced for the water used to fill people's pools.

There were no customer concerns.

Under new business, Greg told everyone that a clarifier at the Wastewater plant needs repaired. He has received a quote for Evoqua in the amount of \$25,823.03. Greg has spoken to Bruce Davis about doing the repair but does not have a quote from Bruce yet.

Sunset Mobile Home Park is charging their residents an additional \$25.00 per month and sent a letter to the residents stating that this charge is from City Utilities. Greg spoke to their management and was told that they would remove the notice from their bill, but the notice is still on the residents' bills currently. Geoff Wesling said that he would write a letter to the owner to remove this statement, because the owner, not City Utilities, is charging an additional \$25.00.

It was Maria Bridges' month to check claims. Maria motioned to approve the claims. Gary seconded the motion. The motion carried.

There was no Mayor's report for the month.

The motion to adjourn was unanimous. The motion carried.
