- Camp registration deadline is June 7th. This is important for the planning of our camp and for us to order shirts. If you miss the deadline, you must talk to Kathi Jackley at the parks department. Please do not just drop off an application late without contacting Kathi.
- Checks can be made payable to The City of Rushville Parks department or cash is also accepted.
- All camp registration fees are non-refundable and non-transferable.
- Payment is due with registration

Rules and regulations

- To ensure the safety of all campers, we expect the campers to conduct themselves in a safe and respectful manner. We will not tolerate bullying or roughhousing. We will do our best to correct behavior as it occurs. Repeat offenders may be required to be picked up from camp and possibly not allowed to return.
- Our camp is outdoors with our shelter being the open amphitheater at Rushville Riverside Park. We will be in the sun and exposed to insects. We plan to take nature walks during our time at camp. Please dress accordingly, including shoes that can get wet. *****Please note that we will have camp even if it rains but if we are expecting storms, we will do our best to contact all when and if we make a decision to cancel.
- We will go to the splash pad at least once during camp. This will be on the camp schedule that will be shared prior to camp.
- Friday July 12th will be a pool safety day followed by pool fun day. We will meet at the Waggner pool on this day.
- Camp hours are from 9 am to 2 pm. Please do not drop your child prior to 8:30 and plan to pick up by 2:30 at the latest.
- If you must drop off or pick up at times different than scheduled, please make sure Kathi Jackley is aware. Sign in and out is required for late drop off and pick up.
- Anyone picking up a child from camp must be on the registration form. If someone other than the parent is picking up the camper, please let us know.
- Additional pick up persons can only be added in person by the parent or guardian and not by phone, text, email or messenger.
